There being few present a motion was made to adjourn to the 28<sup>th</sup> inst to meet at this place at 7 o'clock in evening. Motion prevailed.

Sept 28<sup>th</sup> 1861 met according to adjournment D. Woodard in the chair - Motion made that we proceed to elect a clerk in the place of C. B. Young whose term of office has <sup>now</sup> expired. Carried.

C. B. Young having received all the votes cast was declared unanimously elected for the term of three years.

Motion that we elect a Treasurer to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of Elder Dickens. Carried. D. Woodard received all the votes cast and declared duly elected for the term of two years.

Motion that we hear the report of the Trustees the motion prevailed. report read and accepted.

Motion to adjourn carried.
