To amend 45.185 (1) and (2) of the tutes, relating to care of the graves of members of the armed forces of the United States.

The people of the state of Wisconsin. represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

45.185 (1) and (2) of the statutes are

amended to read: 45.185 (1) Every town board, village board, or common council of every city shall at all times see that the graves and tombstones of all * * * members of the armed forces of the United States, including women's auxiliary organizations created by act of Congress, who shall at any time have served in * * * any branch of the armed forces of the United States, and of the wives or widows of all such soldiers, sailors or marine members, receive proper and decent care, and may employ all necessary assistance to carry out the provisions of this section.

The expense of the care of such graves and tombstones shall be borne by the respective counties where the said graves are located, except where suitable cara de omerwise provided. The ar sunt of expense so charged the county for such care shall not exceed the charge made for the care of other

graves in the same cemetery.

(2) It shall also be the duty of such

* * bodies to report to the county clerk of their respective counties, on or before September 1 of each year, the respective locations of the graves so taken care of by them, together with the name and command to which every such * * * member of the armed forces of the United States, including women's auxiliary organizations created by act of Congress belonged, his or her rank at the date of death, and the amount claimed for such care for a fiscal year from July 1 to June 30.
