A discussion of the cost of Perpetual Care resulted in a change from \$50.00 to \$75.00 effective as of Jan. 22, 1970. Anyone buying a new lot will be required to pay for Perpetual Care at the time of purchase. Yearly dues raised from \$2.00 to \$3.00. Sexton's
