

**MEETING OF THE PLAN COMMISSION OF THE  
VILLAGE OF LAKE DELTON  
March 7, 2016**

Upon giving proper notice pursuant to Section 19.84 Wis Stats, and certifying compliance with the open meeting law, a Meeting of the Plan Commission of the Village of Lake Delton was called to order on Monday, March 7, 2016 at 1:00 P.M. at the Kay C. Mackesey Administration Building.

Present were Chairman John Webb; Tom Diehl, Wally Czuprynko and Gordon Priegel. Absent were Doug Clausen and David Schultz.

Also attending were Attorney Richard Cross, Director of Public Works Gary Hansen, Kevin Gruber, Mark Whitfield, Tom Holtz, Fire Chief Darren Jorgenson, Gary Wegner, First Weber, Cary Brandt and the news media.

Motion by Wally Czuprynko, Second by Tom Diehl for adoption of the meeting agenda. Motion carried.

A Public Hearing was held to consider the request of Darlyn Wittig, for a Conditional Use Permit, pursuant to Municipal Code, Chapter 66, Subchapter 66.63 (o) at 1150 E Hiawatha Drive, Waterfront Commercial District, Tax Parcel 146-088 to continue the use of the premises for short-term rentals.

Gary Wegner from First Weber spoke for the owner who was unable to attend. The home has been licensed for many years but has never received a Conditional Use Permit.

When asked if the property was being sold, Mr. Wegner stated that it was not on the market at this time.

David Schultz had informed the Commission that parking appears to be a problem at that location at times.

No one in attendance spoke in opposition.

Motion by Tom Diehl, Second by Wally Czuprynko to close the public hearing and to recommend approval of a Conditional Use Permit pursuant to Municipal Code, Chapter 66, Subchapter 66.63 (o) at 1150 E Hiawatha Drive, to allow them to continue the use of the premises for short-term rentals. Motion carried.

Motion by Tom Diehl, Second by Wally Czuprynko to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
